Reimbursement Policy



The objective of this course is to gain experience as an EKG technician using the following skills:





This twelve week course is structured to be a preparatory class to successfully pass an introductory to intermediate State competency exam in order to be licensed and work in the wastewater field.

Further, as 2023 is a license renewal year, please be aware that this course is also a State of Massachusetts approved class for obtaining Training Contact Hours where you may obtain as many hours as you need to satisfy State requirements.

The course will introduce the student to the physical and chemical processes associated with water quality, pollution, and treatment of liquid wastes, as they pertain to Municipal and Industrial Operations. The student will be exposed to the function of related equipment and support systems and the environmental responsibilities required to safely and properly operate and maintain a Wastewater Treatment Facility. Topics covered include municipal wastewater treatment processes, industrial wastewater treatment processes, collection systems, regulations, laboratory and math.
